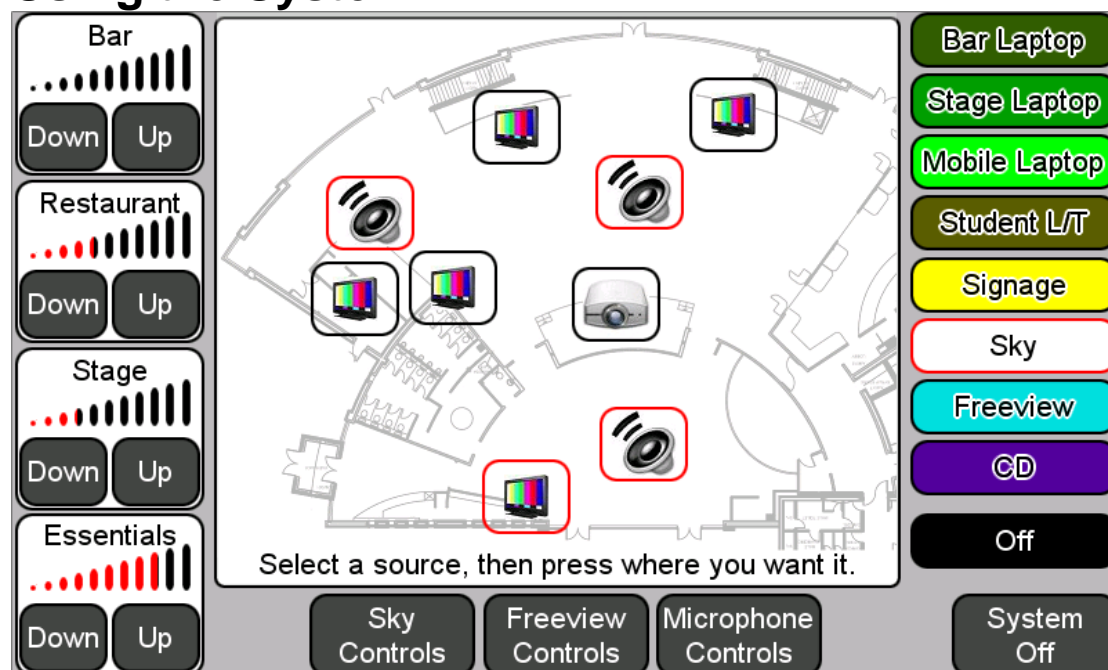

Using the System



Choosing Sources

To choose a source:

- Select it from the right hand side of the screen. It will highlight in red, as the 'Sky' button is above.
- Press the projector, screen or speakers that you wish to send it to. The destination will highlight red.

When a source is selected, all of the places that it is being sent will highlight red, so in the picture above Sky is being sent to the Essentials screen and the PA in the Galleria, the Lounge and in Essentials.

Controlling Volume

To change the volume in an area, use the up and down buttons on the left hand side of the screen. The bars above indicate how loud the audio currently is in that area.

Laptops

The RKC does not have a resident PC, so a laptop will be required to show PowerPoint or web content.

Laptops can be connected on the stage, behind the bar, or next to the pool table.

At the End of Your Session

At the end of your session, please press the 'System Off' button. This will turn the hardware off and save power.

Using Microphones



Selecting Microphones

On the grid, a 'tick' indicates that the microphone is routed to that area. A 'cross' indicates that it is not. To route / un-route a microphone, press the tick / cross.

Volume

The volume of the microphone can be turned up or down using the buttons towards the left of the page. A microphone's maximum volume is 10dB.

Use the Desk

The 'Use the desk' button will route the radio microphones via the sound desk, which can be found in the left most cupboard on the stage. The desk can then be routed to zones as required. There are additional auxiliary inputs in the right hand cupboard, which also feed to the desk.
