## HOW TO BOOK

#### **BOOKING ONLINE:**

#### **BOOKING BY PHONE:**

## **GETTING HERE**

#### BY CAR:

The postcode for the Scenic Stage Theatre is YO10 5DD. There is parking available at various places around the campus. Please use the link below and select 'car parks', or 'accessible parking' to see your options:

#### BY BUS:

Bus lines U1, U2, U3 and 6 stop directly on the campus, and the TFTI building (and Scenic Stage Theatre) are located a short walk away.

### **GETTING HERE**

#### BY TRAIN:

The nearest station to us is York train station. Taxis are available from the station rank outside to get to the university, or alternatively, buses run from outside the station that will take you directly to campus. Look for buses U1 or U2, which leave from across the road of the station, and check that they say 'University of York' on the top.

#### BY BIKE:

We have plenty of bike parking on campus. Please bring your own bike lock.

## **FACILITIES**

#### TOILETS:

We have four different toilets on the ground floor of the building: male, female, unisex and accessible.

Our accessible toilet is accessed with a regular handle tilt lock, rather than a radar key. There are grab bars surrounding the toilet.

#### **VENDING MACHINES:**

There are both food and drink vending machines located in the lobby of the building. These currently accept cards only.

## THE AUDITORIUM

#### **ACCESS:**

The Auditorium can be accessed via a lift. Please ask a member of staff if you require assistance and they will be happy to help.

#### **SEATING:**

The performances of 'Image of an Unknown Young Woman' are being held in the Scenic Stage Theatre.

Our theatre can seat 220 people, and has removable seating for those in wheelchairs. If you book an accessible ticket, and require a spot for a wheelchair, please let us know by emailing tfti-events@york.ac.uk.

# THE SHOW

#### **CONTENT WARNINGS:**

Explores challenging topics and themes, including death, violence, kidnapping, sexual violence, grief, physical abuse.

These topics are brought up and referenced throughout the play.

#### MAY CONTAIN:

Flashing/strobing lights throughout the performance, live fire (towards the end of the performance), sudden loud noises (throughout the performance)

#### THE PERFORMANCE:

The show runs for an approximate time of 90 minutes with no interval.

## **EMERGENCIES**

#### **EVACUATION:**
