We've hosted two training events for DoHS researchers...

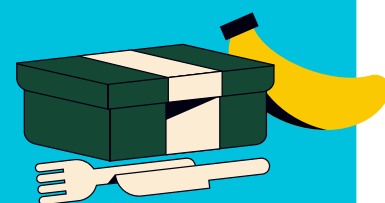
