This must include a minimum of: Continue direct observations of practice (DOPs) as required 10 x Mini-CEX 8 x Case based discussion 8 x Critical reflections 1 Multisource feedback (MSF) or Team Assessment of Behaviours (TAB) Achieved the requirements to enter End Point Assessment in accordance with End Point Assessment plan for the Apprenticeship Standard 'Advanced Clinical Practitioner' ST0564 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Active registration with statutory health and or social care regulator</li> <li>• Achieved English and Maths at a minimum of level 2 or equivalent</li> <li>• Achieved 160 credit from the programme and associated off the job hours</li> <li>• Confirmation of achievement from employers that requirements of apprenticeship agreement and knowledge, skills and behaviours from the standard has been met within the workplace</li> <li>• Confirmation by employer of apprentices' readiness to progress to end point assessment</li> </ul> All elements to be achieved for progression to end point assessment.
