

- Setting up a bank account and registering with a doctor





APPLICATION PROCESS

Submit your application form

You'll be guided through the process, including what documents you'll need to send with or after your application.

Receive a study offer

Once your complete application has been reviewed, you'll receive an unconditional or conditional offer, or we can explore other options with you. We'll send a decision within one working day. For conditional offers, you'll need to satisfy any conditions stated in your offer letter.

Accept your offer

You'll do this by completing and returning your offer acceptance form, and by paying your deposit to study or sending your financial guarantee. Once you've accepted your offer, you can book housing through Kaplan Living.

Obtain your Student visa

To study a degree preparation course in the UK, you'll need to obtain a Student visa. We'll advise you on this important process and provide supporting documents that you'll need for your visa application once you've fulfilled any conditions of your offer.
