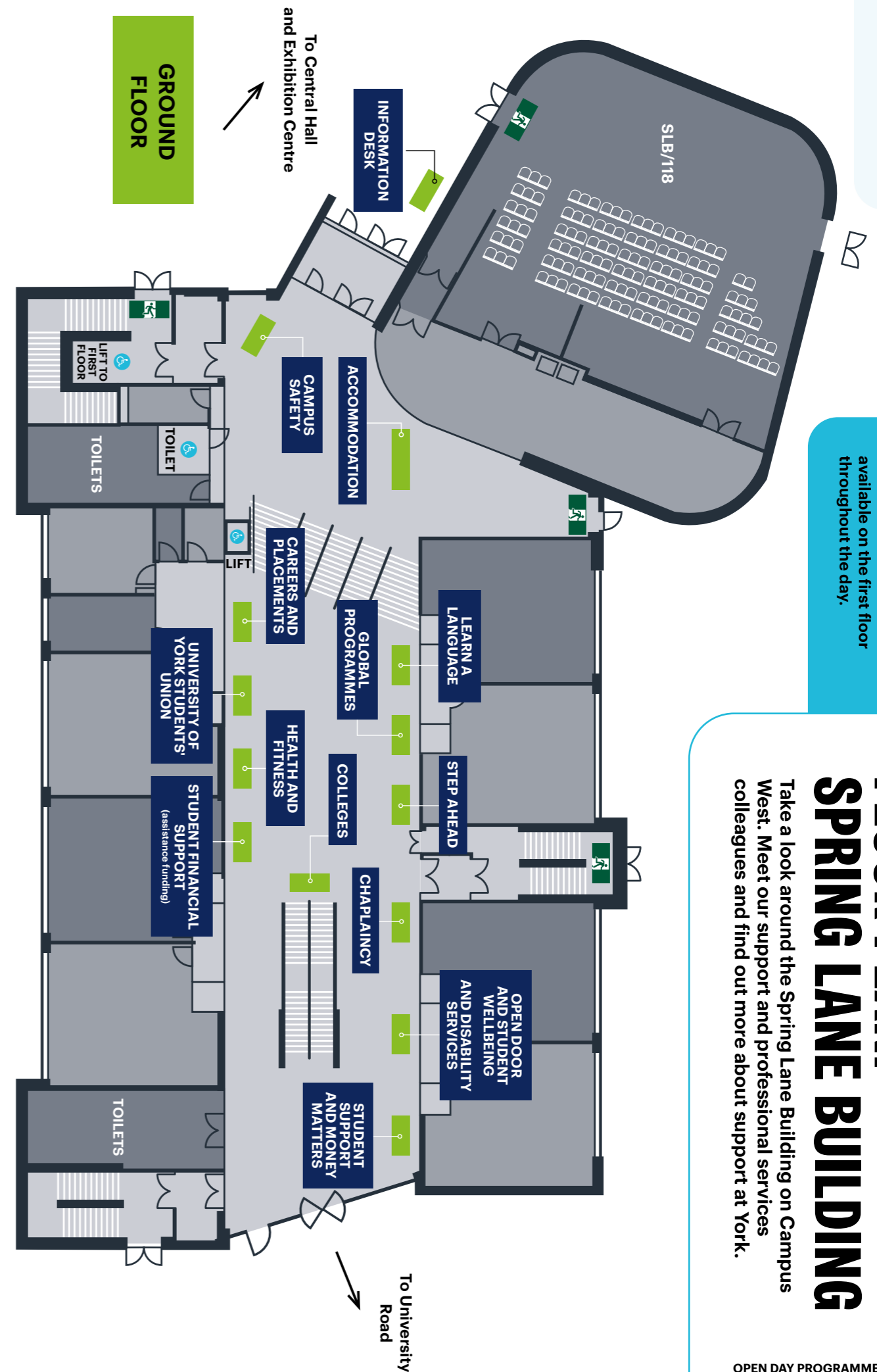

ACCOMMODATION AND COLLEGES

We're proud to be one of just a handful of UK universities with a collegiate system. When you join us you'll become a lifelong member of a distinct community, which will be your home from home, whether you live on or off campus.

Your college will provide you with a network of support and a calendar of events and activities to help you settle in, develop skills and explore your interests.

Each of our colleges has its own unique history, layout, location, facilities and members, as well as accommodation. Whichever department you're studying in, you can apply for rooms in any of our colleges.

While you're on campus, take the opportunity to ask our Student Ambassadors what they like about their college and visit a wide range of rooms. Common room space will be open to view in James College **W** and Langwith College **E**.

Rooms to view

Rooms are open to view today from 9.15am–4.00pm.

If you don't have much time today, we recommend visiting a shared and ensuite bathroom option so you can see the variety of accommodation available.

The table on page 6 shows which room types are available for viewing today and in which college.

See our **Open Day Map** (page 17/18) to locate our colleges or follow the signs and look out for the college coloured lollipops to find the rooms available to view.

All accommodation comes with:

- **Bills included in the price of your rent**
- **No additional costs to worry about**
- **Contents insurance and 24 hour security** to give you peace of mind
- **An ensuite or shared bathroom** and a private washbasin
- **Wifi and 100mb wired internet** so that you can browse uninterrupted
- **Access to a shared kitchen** to cook your meals and hang out with flatmates
- **Access to a college common room** for some extra communal space



What happens next?

Full time students who have confirmed a firm or insurance offer can apply for accommodation when applications open in Spring.

Prices, let lengths and T&Cs will be available to view in spring 2025 for the 2025/26 academic year.

Room offers are sent out from mid August (UK A-level results day), and will contain an offer of a room detailing the college, room type and let length.

All applications are considered and rooms are not allocated on a "first-come, first-served" basis, but use a computerised auto-allocation system to select impartially from the applicants based on preferences.

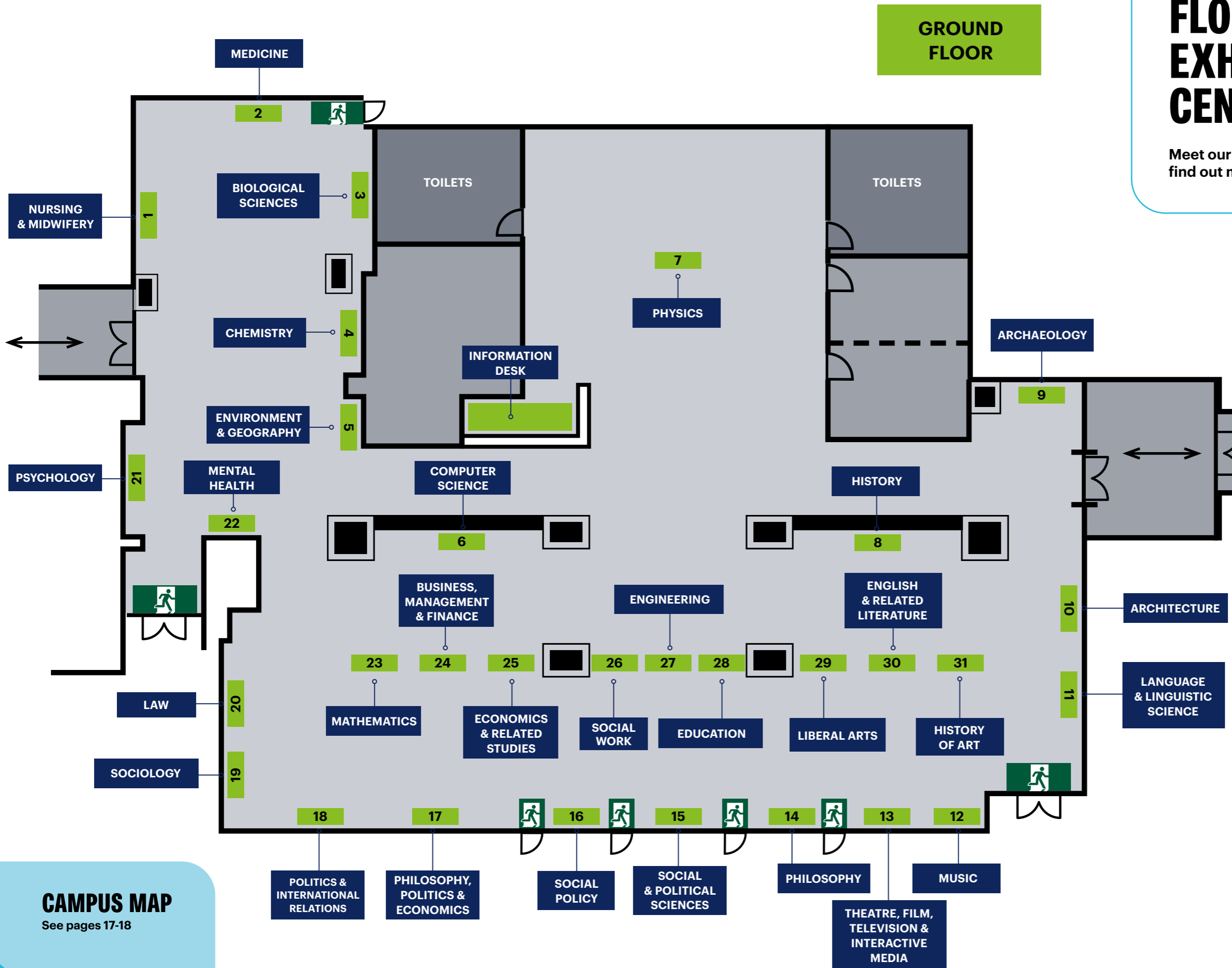

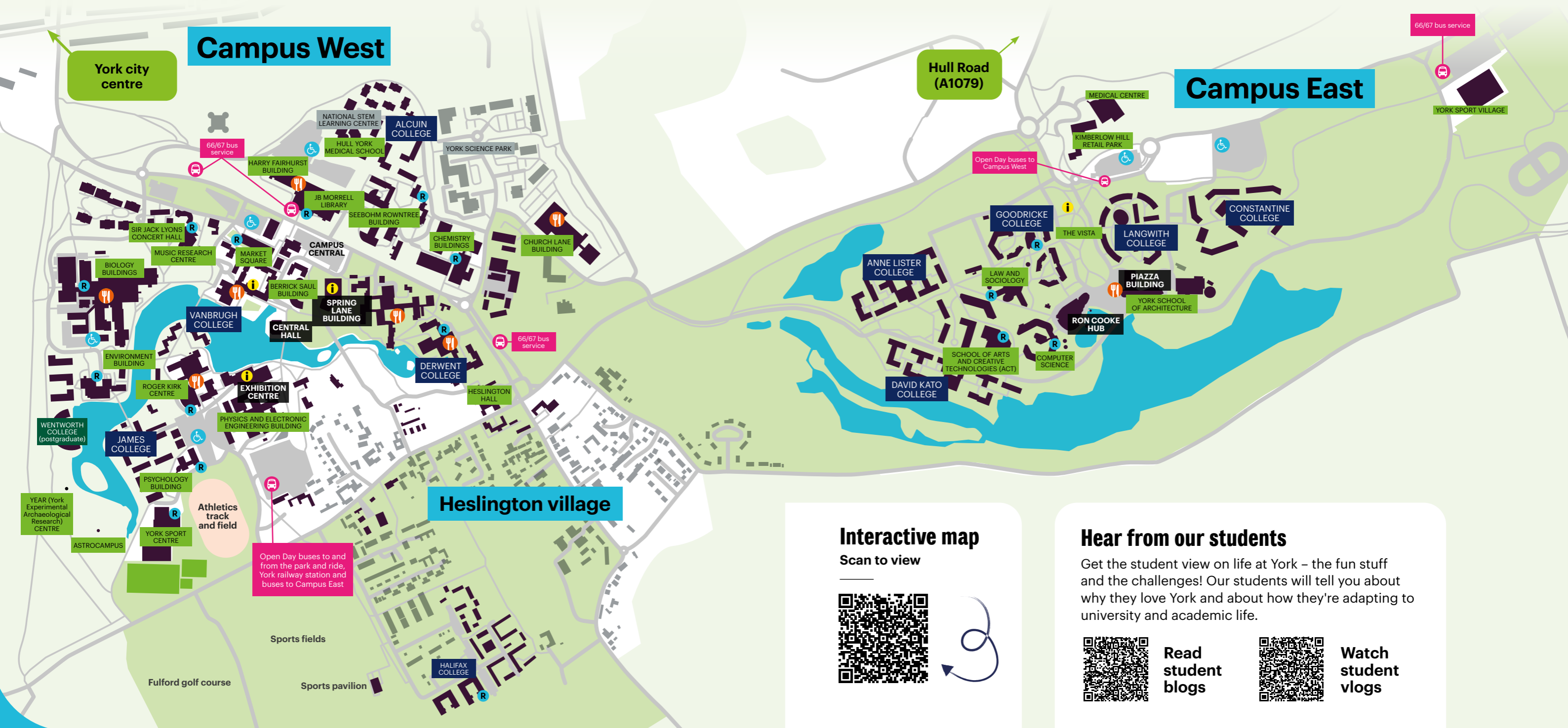
There is a free shuttle bus service running from Campus South Car Park on Campus West to Field Lane Car Park on Campus East.
